# Studfold

Caravan and Camping Park

## Shop

Please check the noticeboard for opening times. We stock a selection of groceries, ice creams, soft drinks, frozen food, toys and gifts. Milk and Sunday papers are available if ordered from reception the previous day. Calor Gas and Camping Gaz are also available upon request.

## Toilet block

Code: C 06 XY

Young children must be accompanied by an adult. Hot water is free but please use sparingly. Please wash dishes and clothes in the deep sinks outside and leave all areas as you wish to find them (if necessary mop showers when finished). Please make sure the door is locked behind you when leaving. Laundry is at the back of the toilet block.

## Water and waste

Drinking water is located down the nearside of the toilet block. Waste water should also be emptied here and not into the Elsan. Chemical fluids should only be placed in the Elsan disposal unit at the back of the toilet block.

## Recycling

Recycling for paper, glass, cans and tins is available on site.

## Consideration for others

To ensure that everyone enjoys their visit to Studfold, we request that all visitors observe the following park rules. Please...

- do not play radios loudly
- keep noise to a reasonable level after 11.00pm
- use the allocated play area for ball games
- do not allow your children to ride cycles around other guests' pitches or climb on walls and fences
- do not use flying fire lanterns
- do not light ground fires of any sort or cause any harm to the environment
- do not smoke, or take dogs, into or around the toilet block

Any serious breach of the park rules will result in you being asked to leave the site immediately.

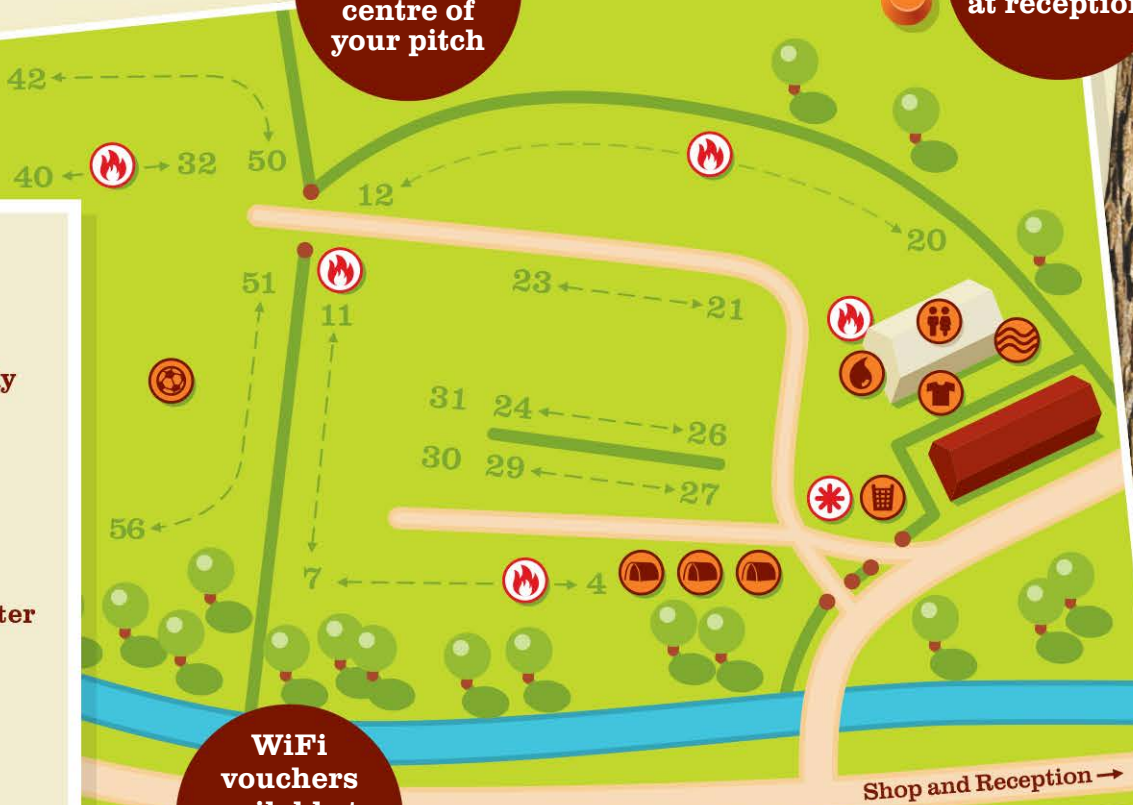
The numbered post is the centre of your pitch

### Enhance your visit

- o **Firepits**  
Firepits are available to hire from reception, there are also logs for sale.
- o **Family games tubs**  
Family games tubs are available to borrow from reception. There is also a children's park at Lofthouse.
- o **WiFi**  
WiFi vouchers can be purchased from reception.
- o **Freezer**  
Located in the laundry room, our new freezer is ideal for your coolbox icepacks.

### Emergencies

Fire extinguishers are located at various points around the camping field (see map).

### Fire precautions

1. Familiarise yourself with the position of the nearest fire box (see map overleaf and plan on the toilet block).
2. Mobile phones don't work in the camping field. The nearest payphone is outside the reception area or inside the farmhouse. A mobile will work at the lay-by on the way to Lofthouse.
3. Ideally each unit should have its own fire extinguisher and means of lighting (torch).

### In case of fire

1. Clear all occupants from your unit.
2. Alert neighbours.
3. Sound the alarm at the fire box by removing the box lid. Wet and dry extinguishers can also be found here.
4. Phone 999 and alert the site office.
5. Gather at the fire assembly point and only return to your unit when it is safe to do so.

### Footpaths

There are no footpaths across adjoining fields. Please respect the farmer's property and keep to recognised footpaths. There is also no right of way from the camping field to the gorge or to Middlesmoor Road. Please access via the road. We also request that you do not walk through the static caravan park.

If you would like advice about local walks, just ask at reception. We have several books available to borrow.

### Eating out

There is a café serving meals all day at How Stean Gorge. Bar meals are available at The Crown, Lofthouse and The Crown, Middlesmoor. Restaurant meals are available at The Yorke Arms, Ramsgill and The Sportsman's Arms, Wath. There are also a selection of fish and chip shops and takeaways available in Pateley Bridge.

### Dogs

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times and exercised off the site. Fields with suckler cows are to be avoided, as the cows are very protective of their calves and may attack people with dogs.

### Mobile phone reception

Mobile phone reception can be found at the lay-by on the way to Lofthouse.

### Camping shelter

If the weather is poor come down to Studfold's Camping Shelter. This is a well lit, covered area with seating where you can eat, drink, chat and keep dry!

### Barbecues and firepit safety

Barbecues and firepits must be raised off the grass and have a cinder and ash collection tray. Bricks can be found in the bin area.

### Departure Time

Please vacate your pitch by 12 noon unless special arrangements have been agreed. Guests visiting the Studfold Trail may, by prior arrangement, vacate their pitch by 3pm on departure day.
