# Studfold

## Caravan and Camping Park

### Arrival Time

Arrival is from 2pm. Reception may be closed during quiet midweek term-time days. If so, please refer to the reception noticeboard for pitch number and contact details.

### Departure Time

Please vacate your pitch or camping pod by 11am unless special arrangements have been agreed.

### Shop

Please check the noticeboard for opening times.

We stock a selection of ice creams, soft drinks, toys, gifts and Studfold Farm Produce (see page 3).

### Toilet block

**Code: C 06 XY**

Young children must be accompanied by an adult.

Hot water is free but please use sparingly. Please wash dishes and clothes in the deep sinks outside and leave all areas as you wish to find them (if necessary mop showers when finished). Please make sure the door is locked behind you when leaving. The laundry and freezer are at the back of the toilet block.

### Water and waste

Drinking water is located down the nearside of the toilet block. Waste water should also be emptied here and not into the Elsan. Chemical fluids and overnight toilets/potties should only be placed in the Elsan disposal unit at the far side of the toilet block.

### Recycling

Please do not place cardboard or general waste in the recycling bin.

### Consideration for others

To ensure that everyone enjoys their visit to Studfold, we request that all visitors observe the following park rules. **Please...**

- Keep radios low at all times and keep all noise to a minimum after 9pm (children) and 11pm (all others)
- Keep dogs on leads, walk them off-site, and clean up after them
- Use the designated play area for ball games
- Do not let children ride bikes around other guests' pitches or near the toilet block
- No waterbombs anywhere; no water pistols near the toilet block
- Do not climb walls or fences
- No flying lanterns or ground fires; help us protect the environment
- Fully extinguish fire pits and BBQs and never leave them unattended
- No smoking or dogs in or around the toilet block
- Enter the Adventure Trail only with a trail booking and during trail opening times


**Children must be supervised by an adult when using play equipment, visiting the toilet block or when near the stream.**

The static caravan park is a private area which is out of bounds for touring visitors.

**Any serious breach of the park rules will result in you leaving the site immediately with no refund.**

## Enhance your stay

### Electric Vehicles

Electric vehicle charge points are located near reception. Do not use the electric boxes in the touring fields to charge electric or hybrid vehicles.

### Firepits

Firepits are available to hire at reception for a fee plus deposit. The deposit will be refunded when the cleaned firepit is returned to reception. Logs are also available to purchase.

### Play areas


Play equipment can be found in the second camping field and there is a children's park in Lofthouse.

### WiFi

WiFi vouchers can be purchased from reception. This may enable WiFi calling on mobile phones.

### Freezer

Located in the laundry room, our freezer is ideal for your coolbox icepacks.



### Hand washing

Remember, you're in the countryside, so it's especially important to wash your hands regularly with warm, running, soapy water.

### Footpaths

There are no footpaths across adjoining fields. Please respect the farmer's property and keep to recognised footpaths. There is also no right of way from the camping field to the gorge or to Middlesmoor Road. Please access via the road. We also request that you do not walk through the static caravan park. Regularly wash your hands using warm, running soapy water.

If you would like advice about local walks, please see page 4 of this pack, ask at reception or take a picture of the walks displayed on the toilet block wall.

### Dogs

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times and exercised off the site. Fields with suckler cows are to be avoided, as the cows are very protective of their calves and may attack people with dogs.

### Mobile phone and television reception

Reception for EE users is usually available on site. For all other providers, reception can be found at the lay-by on the way to Lofthouse. If your mobile phone has a WiFi calling function, WiFi vouchers are available at reception. Television reception is only available via satellite.

### Camping shelter

If the weather is poor come down to Studfold's Camping Shelter. This is a well lit, covered area with seating and a communal BBQ, where you can eat, drink, chat and keep dry!

### Barbecues and firepit safety

Barbecues and firepits should not be left unattended. They must be raised at least 6"/15cm off the grass, have an ash collection tray and be extinguished after use.

## Emergencies

**Fire extinguishers** are located at various points around the camping field (see map). There is a **defibrillator** outside the Cafe and also in Lofthouse village.

### Fire precautions

1. Familiarise yourself with the location of the nearest fire box (see map overleaf).
2. Establish where/how to get the best mobile phone reception at the start of your stay (see right for details).
3. Each unit should ideally have its own fire extinguisher and means of lighting (torch).

### In case of fire

1. Clear all occupants from your unit.
2. Alert neighbours.
3. Sound the alarm at the fire box by removing the box lid. Wet and dry extinguishers can also be found here.
4. Phone 999 and alert the site office.
5. Gather at the fire assembly point and only return to your unit when it is safe to do so.


